Below is a list of scholarships you may apply to. Many are local while others are national. Almost all of the scholarships, if not all, are open for eligible candidates every year. Eligibility requirements, award amount, and deadlines vary; therefore, make sure to visit the website below each scholarship to become familiar with those details. If the link doesn't connect you to the scholarship website, you can visit Google and search the name of the scholarship.

## 6. Diamante Scholarship

- Scholarship Award: Minimum of \$750
- Eligibility: the applicant must be a NC High School graduating senior / incoming freshman or sophomore student attending an institution of higher education (College/University), must be at least 50% of Hispanic-Latino descent, submit high school transcript with a minimum C+ or 2.5 grade point average and submit either SAT or ACT scores, and submit a letter of recommendation from a high school principal, a college counselor or a community leader.

- Scholarship Award: Maximum of \$11,100
- Deadline: 1/31, annually
- For whom: Graduating high school seniors from a 14-county area of NC who plan to enroll as full-time students in a degree-granting program at NC State University, UNC-Chapel Hill, or UNC-Greensboro

## 10. ACS-Hach Land Grant Undergraduate Scholarship

- To be eligible →
  - Be enrolled as a full-time student at one of their partner institutions
  - Major in chemistry and complete educational program

- Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- Express the intention to teach high school chemistry after graduation

#### **35. SAY YES & FIRST GENERATION SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Scholarship Award: includes full tuition, fees and books during the academic year
- Deadline: February 15, annually
- High Point University (HPU) is pleased to support and award five prestigious Say Yes Scholarships with at least two of these being First Generation Scholarships to Guilford County School students living in High Point, North Carolina. Students are highly encouraged to live on campus and state and federal need- based assistance will be explored, after filing a FAFSA to help cover these costs. Preference is given to full-time students, but part-time students may apply. Preference will be given to foreign-born applicants or native-born children of foreign-born parents.

- **Scholarship Award: \$1000**
- **Deadline: August 01, 2019**
- **Description:** This award is for minority students attending a historically black college or university. The applicant must be a graduating high school senior, transfer student, or a student currently enrolled full-time.
