

#### POLICY UPDATES (AS OF 2/23)

The Biden Administration announced an end to the COVID-19 emergency on May 11, 2023, which will end the Title 42 border restrictions as well. Title 42 allows the CDC to suspend entry of individuals into the U.S. to protect public health. It is expected that immigration activity at the border will increase if Title 42 is lifted, and that new actions it will be taken to regarding border enforcement. (https://www.kff.org)

Nine states asked a federal judge in Texas to shut down DACA once and for all earlier in February. A timeline for when the ruling might be expected is not yet clear. United We Dream is a good source to stay up to date with this situation and to find resources to help DACA-mented youth.
